Any yacht retiring must notify OOD as soon as possible.

START & FINISH LINE

Between the main mast of the committee boat moored off Swan Island and Mark 1s located off Cook Street Quay

COURSES

A Bar Buoy to port, Fairway Buoy to starboard, Mark Y to starboard, Bar Buoy to port

B Bar Buoy to port, Fairway Buoy to starboard

C Bar Buoy to port

SHORTENING COURSE

If code flag S is flown with the class flags, the course will be a mark north of Rock Angus to Starboard.

Low water Strangford 12.50

Time limit: Any yacht failing to finish by 1500 hours will be deemed to have retired.

After racing crews are invited to Prizegiving and BBQ (Butcher in attendance), Live MUSIC and BAR at the Clubhouse, Castleward. A ferry service will be provided for yachts mooring in Castleward Bay.
