Failure to comply with this rule will result in the yacht being recorded as a non-starter. Any yacht retiring must notify the Race Officer as soon as possible. START & FINISH LINE

Between the red and white pole of the committee boat moored off Swan Island and Mark 1s located off Cook Street Quay.

Note: To avoid risk of collision please give way to the Strangford-Portaferry Ferry which will be in operation during racing.

COURSES

- A Bar Buoy to port, Fairway Buoy to starboard, Mark Y to starboard, Bar Buoy to port
- B Bar Buoy to port, Fairway Buoy to starboard
- C Bar Buoy to port

SHORTENING COURSE

If code flag S is flown with the class flags, the course will be a mark north of Rock Angus to Starboard. Low water Strangford 19.30

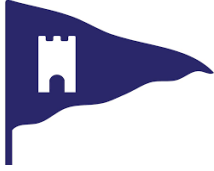
Time limit: Any yacht failing to finish by 2115 hours will be deemed to have retired.

Strangford Sailing Club is delighted to welcome competitors and guests to the Bar Buoy race and SSC Regatta.

To ensure the safety of everyone and minimise the likelihood of spreading Covid-19 could we please request that;

- All competitors shall register their boats using the QR Code or at <https://forms.gle/dqrzqHTvss46KGge9>
- All competitors & guests shall use the Track and Trace online form which will be provided on the ferry boats and at SSC.
(A paper copy shall be available should it be required)
- All competitors and guests shall abide by current Government Covid-19 guidance
 - Social distancing
 - Hygiene
- Clubhouse
 - Closed except for use of toilets.
 - Restricted numbers will apply
- Ferry boats
 - Will ferry one 'bubble' at a time
 - Passengers to wear masks
 - Hand sanitizer and masks will be available
- Bar
 - Table service only
 - Contactless payments only
 - Table restrictions
 - six if those persons are from more than one household, or
 - ten if those persons are from one household or one bubble.

Consolidated Regulations (22 June 2021)*
 - When not seated at a table please wear a mask
- BBQ
 - Use of BBQ to be restricted to one bubble at a time
- Regatta Tea
 - This will be self-service (except for Tea/ coffee)
